Luke was a physician and a traveling companion of the Apostle Paul. The Gospel of Luke is a carefully researched letter focusing on the person, work, and compassion of Jesus Christ. Luke's portrayal of Jesus offers meaningful insights for modern followers of Jesus. Luke highlights Jesus' deep and abiding care for people, regardless of their social status or past mistakes. Luke offers many stories that are not found in the other three biographies of Jesus and is the only one to have a sequel (Acts). As you encounter God through His Word, you're taking an important step in deepening your faith.
